The Conneaut Lake Area Historical Society is pleased to announce our Century Program to recognize and honor the many historic homes and buildings in the Conneaut Lake area. This program celebrates structures of longevity and historical significance. Together with the owners, we research, document, archive and share their stories.

Eligibility for inclusion in this program includes:

- The building must be at least 100 years old
- The integrity of the original design, appearance and details of the building are honored
- The historical significance of the building is considered
- The building is located in Conneaut Lake Borough, Sadsbury, Summit, Greenwood and parts of Vernon Townships

Building owners are encouraged to submit an application. We welcome their research and our Historical Society staff will assist in further research, if desired.

Those homes and buildings that meet the criteria and spirit of the program will:

- Receive a personalized cast bronze plaque depicting the year the structure was built, as well as an identifying number. The plaque will be affixed to the front of the building with help from the Historical Society
- The ID number will reference additional information in our archives, on our website and, as the program develops, inclusion in a museum display.
- Participation in the Century Program is honorary in nature. It does not include the restrictions found in State or National Historic Designation
